What Dance Is This?

As a wannabe caller, I have started studying contra choreography and collecting dances. This includes buying books by well known callers like Tony Parkes or searching dance archives on the web, but also means grabbing some paper and a pencil after a fun dance finishes and jotting down the figure. Most callers are happy to let you look at their card if you ask before they put it away. It's proper to note the author of the dance so as to attribute it correctly when you call it.

However, this dance was found well after the event - I saw a video taken during Blue Moon V by one of our members, and wrote down the parts. I have been trying to be a "dance detective" and identify it, but have had no success so far.

Here is the dance:

- A1 do-si-do neighbor 1 1/4 to wave (ladies in the middle) balance wave
- A2 ladies allemande Left half a Hey
- B1 neighbor Balance & Swing men allemande L 1 1/2
- B2 partner swing circle left 3/4 pass thru to new neighbor

So, can you help me? Does anyone recognize it? Give me a call or send an email if you know the name and author of this contra. Thanks. - Doug Roth
