Steers Meeting Held

"The north wind doth blow, we almost had snow, and what did your steers do then, poor things?"

Well, we had a meeting at the Mebane's on January 16th. Carol's soup & corn bread warmed us up and we got a lot accomplished. See the article below.

This meeting was mentioned in the last issue, but hadn't been fully scheduled at press time. The time and place were negotiated via email thru our "nacdssteer" list. You can be on it by signing up at our web site. Find the URL in the masthead above.

By the way - we're called the steers because whoever shows up at a meeting is automatically a member of the informal "steering committee" of the dance group. It has nothing to do with neutered cattle.

Changes in what we Charge

While most of the business attended to at the steers meeting had to do with our next Blue Moon dance weekend, more prosaic issues were dealt with as well. Primary among them: finances.

The NACDS is a not-for-profit corporation. Our officers are all volunteers; no one is paid a salary. The group does have expenses though. We pay \$40 per night to rent the gym at the church. Our sound system equipment must be maintained - broken or worn out items are replaced. The callers and musicians who perform for our dances are paid as well.

Over the years the money we pay our musicians and callers has generally fallen behind the going rate. We want to make it worth their while to come and work 3 plus hours for us on a Saturday night. In order to pay a bit more, we need to charge a bit more.

Starting March 1, 2003 the cost of admission to the dances will increase by \$1 per person. The new rates are: \$7 for non-members, \$6 for members and \$4 for teens. Those 12 & below still dance for free. The last price increase was effective in July of 1999.

The cost of membership in the NACDS has been \$8 per year since at least the early 1990's. Effective March 1st, the yearly dues will increase to \$10 for individuals and \$15 for families. You may renew or extend your membership at the current rate until the end of February.

Dance Adventures

The night of the steers meeting, your editor returned home to find an email from a corespondent in the Nashville group informing us that Bela Fleck, well known musician and banjo magician, would be sitting in with Russ Barenburg & Friends (two fiddlers!) at their Friday dance the 17th.

Long story short: my son and I drove up the next evening, braving seven inches of snow in the Music City, and danced with the Nashville Country Dancers. Susan Kevra called, the music was great, and we got to hang out with Bela & Russ a bit during the break.

We were gently chided the Saturday at our Huntsville dance for not forwarding the announcement to the steers list & let everyone else know. I'm sorry. I was so surprised that the logistics of our excursion worked out in spite of everything, that it slipped my mind that I should have passed the email on. Mea culpa.

In other news: I went to visit the Rocket City Cloggers recently. They meet most Mondays in the Optimist Community Center on Oakwood east of 565 at 7 PM. There are lessons for beginners, and the performance group dances at several events each year. Check them out!
