## **Contra Courtesies**

I know this is "preaching to the choir" for many of us, but it's helpful to review certain points of dance etiquette from time to time. This month we'll cover dancing with beginners. Here goes:

First of all, smile and welcome newcomers. Help them to have fun. Be encouraging. They may feel shy or unsure of themselves. Remember that there was a first dance for all of us.

Occasionally come early enough to help in the beginners workshop. They will learn faster if they have a good model of how the various figures are done. Show them how to give weight and make eye contact with fellow dancers.

Mention to people who are "just watching" that the dances are easier early in the evening. Offer to answer their questions or explain some dance terminology like "hands four" or "improper formation."

Help your partner end swings in the correct position and direction. Don't do extra twirls and spins, especially in courtesy turns. Let them learn the basics before adding flourishes.

Be on time for the next move. Explain how the music and dance go together, and that if you're late for a figure, to skip it or cut it short rather than rush to make up time.

Point out that it's usually a good idea for two new dancers not to dance together for the first few dances. Have them ask experienced dancers instead. Later in the evening they'll be better partners for each other as a result.
