Dance News

The steers meeting at the Walls on January 11th was reportedly (alas I could not make it) very productive. Our next Blue Moon Dance Weekend is shaping up nicely, and several aspects of the weekend and logistics, etc. were decided.

There was also a discussion about "5th Saturday" dances. Our long standing policy had been that these extra dances - about 4 per year - were open-mike opportunities for budding musicians and callers. But, for diverse reasons, half of last years 5th Saturday dances were dropped. At the meeting it was decided that our official schedule be changed to have 1st and 3rd Saturday dances 'and occasional special dances' which we could have whenever we wanted.

In light of the above, it is gratifying to point out that over January 30-31 there were dance events at four (4!) different places in the region (Sewanee, Huntsville, Gorham's Bluff, and Rome, Ga.) and each of them was a big success. The dance in Huntsville was great despite many of our dance gypsies being elsewhere. Archie Faulkner from Birmingham was the caller, and a new band, tentatively called "Weapons of Mass Delight" premiered. The musicians involved were: Chip Gulbro - fiddle, Curt Lewis - bass, plus Jim Holland - banjo and Steve Nix - guitar.

Introducing "Dance Buddy" Tags

Every traditional dance community needs beginners. If we attract new dancers, our group will thrive; if not, it will wither. To retain our new dancers, and to help them quickly become more confident, we have started to provide "Dance Buddy" labels at our dances.

Experienced dancers who can help teach, explain and demonstrate may identify themselves by wearing one of these stickers. New comers will be encouraged to dance their first few dances with a "Dance Buddy" and also to feel free to approach them with questions.

If you have found yourself correcting a too-tight allemande grip, suggesting a more comfortable swing technique, or in some other way gently assisting a less experienced dancer, why not consider coming to the dance at 7 for the class, wearing one of these tags and becoming a "Dance Buddy."

Waltz Workshop - February 21st

Barb Kirshner will teach an 'advanced beginner to intermediate' level waltz workshop at Faith starting at 4 with live music by Tom Kat & the Fiddle. Cost: \$5 per person. The aim will be to brush up your waltz skills: turns, side-by-side moves, etc. Sort of "How to have fun while waltzing."

A **Potluck supper** will follow the workshop, so bring something easy to eat. We'll only have an hour between the workshop and the newcomer's class.
