At The Dances

There are those that give their time by showing up early to open the doors and prepare the hall for our evening of fun. We have others that take care of the sound and electronics, including the storage and transport of this equipment to and from the dances. There are those that take turns attending the entrance table and greeting folks as they arrive. Some folks help newcomers by wearing a "Dance Buddy" badge to show willingness to assist them with their first few dances. Others bring fans and/or food to make all of us more comfortable. Then there are bands and callers that share their talents for minimal compensation, because of their love of this type of communal experience. After the dance there are those who take a few moments to put up chairs and sweep the floor.

Between The Dances

Every few months we have a Steering Committee meeting. Those who attend - and this is open to anyone - give an hour or two of their time so that many will benefit. The meetings shape the direction of our regular dances as well as our annual Blue Moon dance weekend.

Other activities include – a Dance Producer giving countless hours throughout the year booking bands and callers; a Newsletter Editor putting together the news on a monthly basis; a Membership Chair keeping up the data base and following up with first time dancers; a Treasurer keeping the money balanced; someone hosting and updating our web site; someone notifying local newspapers of the dances; someone creating flyers and ads; various people opening their homes to house out of town bands, dancers and callers – the list goes on! All these tasks are done by volunteers. The act of giving of one's time and talents is part of the camaraderie that keeps our group going.

Please consider Volunteering in 2005 and making the dances even more enjoyable for everyone. Even a small amount of your time helps! So, enjoy the dance, but remember that it would not happen without those who care enough to give up some of their time!
