# JULY 20 STEERING COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Attendees: Jane Ewing, Kevin & Kathy Riggs, Carol Mebane, Doug Roth, Erin Maquire, Claire Davies. The meeting was held at the home of Kevin and Kathy Riggs.

Meeting was called to order by Carol Mebane.

The minutes of the last meeting in April were read and accepted.

Carol reported that the nominating committee had presented a slate of officers for next year to the membership at the July 5<sup>th</sup> dance. The proposed officers were: Carol Mebane – President, Erin Maguire – President Elect, Jane Ewing – Treasurer, Claire Davies – Secretary, Doug Roth – Producer, Steve Nix – Equipment, Mark Mohon – Membership, and Kevin Riggs – Newsletter. At the July 19<sup>th</sup> dance, there were no alternate nominations from the floor. The membership voted to accept the officers as presented.

Carol also mentioned the recent acquisition by the group of 2 additional speakers and stands before the Blue Moon dance. It was felt that the increased crowds the bi-weekly dances would benefit from the better sound system.

Treasurer's Report - Jane presented a spreadsheet showing a breakdown of attendance for the dances since the start of the year, along with an expense breakdown. While the Blue Moon weekend was in general a success, figures show a loss of a little over \$500. Attendance was off from last year by a dozen or so people. It was noted that with six or seven more weekend registrations we would have broken even. The high gas price was sited as a possible cause for the low attendance. We will need to aggressively advertize next year's dance with Wild Asparagus. We have been making a small profit on the last 6 dances. The July 5th dance was particularly good due to students being home and gas prices being high.

In regards to the tax status of NACDS, Jane report that she filed the tax forms April 4<sup>th</sup>.

#### OLD BUSINESS:

George Mitchell has responded that Wild Asparagus has the Blue Moon dance on their schedule. For our dance it was requested that we ascertain that a fiddle player be among the band members.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

Carol mentioned that Jerry offered to be our contact with UAH again this year. He will pursue reserving the dates for next

year's Blue Moon. Several board members raised concerns about the size of the hall and questioned how many dancers it can comfortable hold. Do we need to consider limiting the registration and/or gender balancing? Some discussion followed on these topics but they were tabled for now.

Production – Doug reported that the production schedule has been worked out for most of the remaining dances. Doug asked for input on which weekend in December should be the Christmas dance. After some discussion of dates and possible conflicts, the general consensus was to have the dance on December 20th. Door Prizes should be recruited and handled as they were last year, hopefully by Mark. We need to advertize this as a special dance. It was decided that there will not be an after dance party due to the closeness to Christmas.

No other business was raised.
