UPCOMING AREA DANCES

Huntsville 12-4: The Kaleidoscope String Band will play for our dance, December 4. The band plays a variety of music, including American old-time, French Canadian, Celtic, and jazz-based tunes. They have played in Alabama, Tennessee, Georgia, and even Costa Rica!
