Huntsville Dance February 5: Music by The Pigweeds and calling by Vicki Herndon.

The Pigweeds are a knockdown Southern old-time band that likes good fiddling, and loves good dancing. Jim Holland on fiddle is a North Alabama local coming from generations of musicians. He and his son have received regional and national music competition awards, and enjoy giving workshops, but mostly they just like to collect and make interesting music. Cole Holland on open-back banjo is a local college student who also enjoys a variety of music. Mike Baugh on guitar makes his home in Nashville, where he is a bedrock of the old-time and dance community. Mike has recorded several projects, is a songwriter and is active in the Nashville Old-time String Band Association.



Vicki Herdon began calling in 2000, and has called all around the southeast. She is an active part of the dance community in Chattanooga, TN. Her specialty is welcoming newcomers and giving them confidence.
