PROPOSED BYLAWS CHANGE

As described on page 3, the following changes to the bylaws were discussed and approved at a Steering Committee Meeting held May 25. At an upcoming dance, the membership will vote whether or not to approve these changes. In preparation, please read the proposed changes, contact an officer if you would like to discuss the proposal, and be prepared to vote at one of the July dances:

Under Article 6: Elected Officers

Change: The elected offers of the NACDS are President, President- Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, Newsletter Editor, Property Custodian, Membership Chairman, and dance series producers. All terms of office are one year, and with the exception of the Property custodian, Newsletter Editor, dance series producers, and treasurer, no individual may hold any given office for more than two years consecutively. The duties of the officers shall be:

Change to Article 6. Elected Officers:

The elected officers of the NACDS are President, President Elect, Secretary, Treasurer, Newsletter Editor, Property Custodian, dance series Producers, and Webmaster. All terms of office are one year, but individuals may to re-elected to successive terms. The duties of the officers shall be:

2. maintain and create content for NACDS Facebook page or other social networking site.

These proposed changes must be published to the membership (accomplished herewith) before they are accepted. We expect to vote on the change during a dance in July.

Carol called meeting to order.

Blue Moon 12:

Feedback forms were reviewed by Erin. Lighting level too high for some – just right for most. More waltzing wanted. Some wanted headline band to play for a workshop on Saturday.

Discussion:

Let headline band determine how much they want to play.

AC cooling problems – we handled okay – in general we need a bit more support from UC housekeeping – lighting: experiment with the spots vs. the fluorescents.

Spragins Hall vs UC for next year? Look into it (but probably not – better floor but poorer acoustics etc.).

Party Saturday – lower than usual attendance by local dancers (rain?) Enough food? Beer? \$ to support?

Scholarships – disappointment that two (of the four) dropped out at last minute.

Enough work - water, sweeping etc. To keep 4 busy. Discussion of better coordination of duties next time.

Need more volunteers - how to encourage?

Financial:

Jane still has a couple bills outstanding, but ballpark: we made \$4000.

Question of whether we 'used' the 5k bequest – conclusion: we might not have tried for wild asparagus if we hadn't gotten it – so "yes"!

Steve suggested that we make a \$ gift to Jeff in the amount that we paid Pat. Appreciation of Jeff's talents and value to the group acknowledged.

New business:

Discussion of officers, board members, & committee chairs

and their duties & functions. Add web master? Remove 2year term limit from the positions that still have it? Overlap of membership roster maintenance duties.

Eventually, Mark moved that the 2 year term limit be removed from Secretary & Membership chair. Jane & Erin second. Carried by voice vote.

Erin moved that Web Master be added as a board position – (no term limit) Jane seconds. Brief discussion. Carries by voice vote.

We are overdue for a slate of officers etc. We need a VP.!!!

Amendments & slate to be printed in newsletter – voted at a dance in July(?)

Discussion of storage possibilities at faith, & dance host volunteers.

Doug moves to adjourn, Erin seconds.

Cooking, rain, food & conversation ensue.
