- **President** has responsibility to make sure that dances run smoothly; leads in planning for the future; sets agendas and presides at Board meetings.
- **President-Elect** organizes the Blue Moon Weekend during the current year; moves into the President's position the next year.
- **Dance Series Producer** schedules bands, callers and the dance hall; coordinates dance hosts (those who set up and clean up at each dance).
- **Secretary** keeps minutes of Board meetings.
- Treasurer manages the bank account and tracks data on income and expenses
- **Newsletter Editor –** produces a monthly newsletter with announcements and general information; prints and mails the newsletter to NACDS members in a timely manner.
- **Property Manager** coordinates the sound system at each dance; sets up and dismantles sound equipment; stores and maintains equipment.
- Membership Chair –maintains data base of current addresses; prints mailing labels for the newsletter and other correspondence; produces a members and friends phone/addresses directory.
