NACDS STEERING COMMITTEE MEETING, MARCH 9, 2009

The meeting was held at Faith Presbyterian Church. Attending were Doug Roth, Bryan Walls, Mark Mohan, Kevin Riggs, Erin Mc Quire, Jane Ewing, Carol Mebane, Natasha Kunin, and Claire Davies. Carol Mebane called the meeting to order.

Current business:

Committee needs to discuss the upcoming Blue Moon weekend. Reservations are running higher than previous years. We currently have 105 reservations. Jane presented information obtained from other dance groups as to the required space needed for a comfortable dance. The hall has been measured and we can fit 4 lines with 11 sets in each line. The estimate is that 176 dancers can be accommodated comfortably on the floor. Discussion followed as to whether we should set this as the limit and at what point to impose gender balancing. It was agreed to delay a decision until we have 160 reservations. Single women's forms will be processed as single guys sign up.

Volunteers will be needed to assist with set up at around 3:00 pm the day of the dance: decorations (Claire for quilts, Carol for plants, & etc.), sign-in (Natasha), housing (John Barnum), and working the table during the dances. Encourage members to get involved and help in some area. Members who want to help can contact committee heads at upcoming dances.

Natasha has noticed a higher request for housing in people's homes. She requested that we start polling members for those willing to provide sleeping space.

Scholarship requests have come in for the three positions. These positions have been given to Carl Shaddox, Judy Snipes, and Harriet Bugle by unanimous approval. These three will be permitted to attend the weekend at no cost for work done.

Food is again limited to small individually wrapped items. The concessions at UAH are all contractually controlled. The snack stand will not be open this year due to problems at the university. We will again provide water and candies but it is limited to that.

Button party will be held later in April, probably at Jane's in Grant. The necessary supplies are on hand. Mark is working on the art work and will have it soon.

New business:

Doug raised the question as to whether or not to schedule a band and caller for the first Saturday in July as it falls on the 4th. After discussion the board voted to go ahead with a dance on the 4th of July.

The meeting was adjourned.
