MONEY MUSK

Our dance traditions have deep roots. While many of the tunes we dance to are very old, and though most of the steps we dance are old, the tradition also grows and adapts over time. But did you know that there is a dance called Money Musk that has survived for some two hundred years? And, unlike other chestnuts (such as British Sorrow) that had faded from use, but were later revived, one version or another of Money Musk appears to have been beloved and danced in New England continuously from that time to this. What's more, the dance is always accompanied by a tune with the same name.

At the October steering committee meeting, Jane Ewing taught the dance to everyone, and it was a great hit. We all thought it would be great fun to try teaching the dance to more people and try it at one of our regular Saturday dances. We think it's a dance that's sure to catch on!

OCTOBER 19NACDS STEERING Committee Meeting

Attendees: Jane Ewing, Kevin & Kathy Riggs, Carol Mebane, Doug Roth, Erin Maquire, Claire Davies, John, Mark Mohon, James Hildreth, Bryan Walls and Steve Nix. The meeting was held at the home of Jane Ewing.

Meeting was called to order by Carol Mebane.

The minutes of the July meeting were accepted as printed in the newsletter.

Treasurer's Report - Jane presented a spread sheet showing a breakdown of attendance for the dances since the start of the year, along with an expense breakdown. We are still breaking about even on dances. Low attendance weekends seem to be due to conflicting events. A motion to accept the financial report was made. The motion carried.

A discussion was held about trimming the newsletter to fewer pages, but since it would still require the same postage, it would not furnish a substantial savings. The ability of emailing newsletters has not been setup as yet.

Old Business:

NACDS organized a concert event at the start of the month to take advantage of a great band being in town with a free performance day due to a schedule cancelation. The Notorious concert on October 3rd was held at the Unitarian Universal Church on Governor's Drive. Thanks to everyone involved with the project and to Steve and Jeff for setting up the sound equipment. A good time was had by those who attended.

New Business:

One of the floor fans has been retired due to a squeaking problem. There is a need to replace the fan and to purchase another to provide the needed air circulation in the gym. A motion was made to purchase two fans similar to the one we have. The motion carried. Carol agreed to research prices at local stores and purchase the fans.

Carol mentioned that Jerry has contacted UAH in regards to reserving the dates for next year's Blue Moon for the hall and Union Chapel. It was suggested that we have Jim & Inge Wood for the second band as they have not preformed on a Blue Moon weekend. The price for the dance weekend was discussed. Other area dance weekends run between \$60 – \$90. Last years dance was \$65. It was mentioned that the hall will comfortably hold 150 dancers. Discussion on the need to adopt a policy on gender balancing was held. It was

suggested that we should include a line stating that the dance is in "appreciation and memory of Mr. Richard Stutzke" in the programs, and that his wife and a guest be invited to attend at no charge.

A volunteer to chair a housing committee will need to contact UAH about using the dorms again this year. Last year the cost for a dorm room was \$19 a night.

Production – Doug reported that the November dance will be Whistlin' Rufus, with Doug Singleton calling. The Christmas dance band will be Crosstown Traffic with Janet Shepherd calling. Ticket prices were discussed and a motion made to set the price at \$10 for adults and \$6 for students. The motion carried. Due to a possible earlier function at the church, the dance start time will be 8:00 pm, instead of the usual 7:30 pm, and will go until 11:00 pm. There will not be an after dance party due to the closeness to Christmas.
