NACDS HOLIDAY DANCE!

Our annual Holiday Dance will be December 19th, at 8:00 p.m. The caller will be Susan Kevra, and music will be provided by Waxwing.

Susan Kevra lives in Nashville, Tennessee, teaches dance and plays music on both coasts and both sides of the Atlantic. She began calling and teaching traditional dances in 1991, appearing in New England grange halls in tiny, snow-covered villages as well as major festivals and dance camps throughout America. She spent 2000 - 2001 in France and traveling throughout Western Europe teaching contras, squares and English Country Dancing – and learning French dances.

Susan is noted for her charm, wit and respect for the traditions she shares. Dancers on both sides of the Atlantic appreciate her clear teaching and diverse repertoire of singing squares, Western patter calls, contras and English Country dances. She has choreographed a number of well loved contra and square dances and is the author of "Trip to Phan Reel" and "The Country of Marriage."

A fine clarinetist and singer, Susan is also a member of the English Country Dance Band, "Meeting House." Her calling and singing can be heard on the critically acclaimed CD, "Full Swing" featuring some of New England's finest contra dance musicians. The CD contains a lengthy and entertaining booklet she wrote tracing the roots of New England contra dancing and a guide for new callers.

Susan teaches French and American Studies at Vanderbilt University.

We hope you know Waxwing – contra-dance music from musicians who love to contra dance!

Based in Huntsville and Birmingham, Alabama, and Clemson, South Carolina, Waxwing plays for dances all over the southeast and beyond. Their music spans many styles, including Celtic, Up East, Quebequois, Old Time, and contemporary tunes with a little classical, jazz, pop, and reggae stirred into the mix.

STEAMSHOVEL

Steamshovel, made up of Roger Gold (guitar, foot drum) and David White (fiddle and banjo) is indeed a dynamic duo in the contra dance world. Roger is well known as one of the finest guitar players on the contra dance circuit, supplying a wonderful combination of intricate melodies, powerful rhythms and big bass sounds, often at the same time! While he has played mostly with fiddlers of the Celtic/New England style in many other bands (Elftones, Land of Sky, Skytones, Goosebone Prophets, Tribal Tune Twisters, and more) Roger has found a powerful rhythmic accomplice in David White. David's selections of unique old time tunes - from driving to groovy and 'flowey' - as well as several tunes he has created for banjo and fiddle, present a great diversity of tunes for dancing and for Roger to play off of. Having played together for 4 years now, their synergy is obvious, and the style that has emerged from this union continues to evolve. They love playing together and inspiring dancers w/ their music. Steamshovel has played regularly at venues in the Carolinas, Tennessee and Georgia, (Atlanta, Sautee, Jonesboro, Chapel Hill, Greensboro, Winston Salem, Charlotte, Charleston, River Falls, Asheville- Gray Eagle/Old Farmers Ball, Columbia and more), recently led the Sunday dance music at the Splash Dance Weekend 09 in Black Mt., NC, played at the Contrathon III (Glendale Springs, NC near Boone) and play regularly for weddings and other special dance and nondance events.
