SEPTEMBER NACDS STEERING COMMITTEE MEETING

[Following are abbreviated minutes from the Sep 16 meeting. The full minutes are public and available by request, but too long to print here. Editor]

Meeting was called to order by Carol Mebane.

A motion to accept the minutes of the June 26 meeting was made by Carol, Mark seconded it. The motion carried.

Treasurer's report: Jane presented a spread sheet showing a breakdown of attendance for the dances since August, along with an expense breakdown. We have been making a small profit at dances except for the last two or three. Low attendance figures are attributed to conflicts with the Mentone Dance weekend and the Labor Day weekend. Jane figures that we need approximately 70 people per dance to make a profit.

Old business: Carol has yet to find a willing candidate to serve as vice president. She is still looking and would appreciate leads.

New business: Carol related that she likes to have planned meetings on a regular schedule. The dates of upcoming steering committee meetings will be the Sunday following the third Saturday dance every other month. (Future meeting dates will be Nov. 18, Jan 20, and March 16.) Meetings will be at members homes, Donna Deaton volunteered to host the Nov. meeting.

A suggestion to have more social events was made and discussed. A cook out at the pavilion on Monte Sano was suggested for sometime in October. Possible dates are to be researched and relayed to the board.

A pressing need for next May's Blue Moon is the contracting of a band. Suggestions for the band in 2008 were Hotpoint Stringband, Air Dance and Lift Tickets. Carol offered to research the availability of these bands, their costs, and their preferences in callers, the tentative list being Joseph Pimentel and Beth Molaro, and report back to the board. For the 2009 dance, the group expressed a preference to secure Wild Asparagus.

Jane Ewing proposed that we join a group that is researching ways to recruit and retain members. She would like us to be a test market group for this area of the country. She encouraged everyone to visit the web site for the group: http://danceambassadors.googlepages.com. It suggests and organized approach of greeters to work with new comers and e-mail surveys to evaluate newcomer satisfaction.

The meeting was adjourned.
