SEPTEMBER 27 STEERING COMMITTEE MEETING

On September 27 an NACDS Steering Committee meeting was held at the home of Trey Brakefield.

Attendees: Jane Ewing, Mark Mohon, Rebecca Holbrook, Gary Nelson, Erin Macguire, Kevin Riggs, Claire Davies, Doug Roth, Steve Nix, Jeff McClure, Trey Brakefield, Bryan Walls, Donna Deaton, Wayne Hitt.

5TH DANCE DISCUSSION

Gary and Rebecca proposed a series of special dances on the 5th Saturdays in 2010: Jan 31, May 25, July 30, and October 30. Gary wants to enhance the dance experience by encouraging new members and for dancers who have stopped attending regularly. He wants to work with the NACDS group, planning the proposed dances and organizing their production. NACDS would fund the dances with the expectation that attendance would cover the cost and some profit. The only unusual expense Gary proposed was \$50 payment to whoever runs the sound equipment. For each 5th Saturday, Gary & Rebecca already plan to have a dinner/concert series in concert with the Flying Monkey.

We discussed the aptness of the proposed dates. The dance near the Blue Moon weekend is not a direct conflict, but it's an adjacent weekend and might stress the organization or force some dancers to choose one or the other. On the other hand, many dancers might think an extra dance would enhance the Blue Moon experience. The Nashville Masquerade Ball will be held on a 5th Saturday, so that would be a direct conflict. We discussed possibly shifting the dates of those dances to address conflicts. For example, the "5th Saturday" dance might be held on a 3rd Saturday at those times.

Dance admission would be a special price. Discussion resulted in the suggestion \$8 for members, \$10 non-members, and \$5 students.

Kevin motioned to support the 4 "5th Saturday" dance series in 2010 to be produced by Gary & Rebecca, with a budget of \$2800. Seconded by Erin. The vote passed unanimously.

CALLER'S MONITOR

Steve & Jeff wanted to discuss a caller's monitor. The usual price is \$200, but venders have recently started raising prices. One vendor still has for \$200, so Jeff would like to buy now.

Jane made a motion to purchase a caller's monitor. Erin seconded, and the vote passed unanimously.

BLUE MOON

Erin contacted Lift Ticket about playing for the dance since the online poll of steering committee members was mostly for this band. Exact price is still in negotiation. We need to watch travel costs & so forth. No caller has been selected, but the group favors Lisa Greenleaf, Kathy Anderson, or Robert Cromartie.

The UAH hall is reserved for the 4th Saturday of May.

BREAK TIME DURING DANCES TAKING TOO LONG

Erin believes we need shorter breaks during regular dances. Need to police the break time & say time's up. Possibly play music (waltz, swing, Cajun) during the break. Need to talk to new people during the break and make them feel welcome.

New BUSINESS:

Publicity: Mark does some radio spots on WLRH; Jane puts some on radio stations in Marshall County. We have been getting dances publicized in the Go section & the Huntsville Times.

New bands: Erin has noticed that some bands at the Huntsville Monday Concert In the Park series are contra-ish. Could we do a display dance at the park? Or at the library or the mall?

There's a **sign-up sheet** for helping at the money table at regular dances. When you sign up, you need to pay attention to the gender balance of the group – if we're not balanced, it's better for the less represented gender to be on the dance floor than at the table.

Carol has proposed that we **purchase a chair caddie & chairs** for our use as a gift to the church. The idea would be to store it in the back room. This would make setup and takedown easier. Need to look into prices.

Holiday dance: it's time to start promoting this. Erin will put together ideas for a flyer. Kevin will begin mentioning this in the newsletter. Dec 19th. Admission planned to be \$10 except students \$5.

Motion to close by Jane, seconded by Erin.
